

HIKING VERMONT

Mount Horrid and The Great Cliff, about 1.2 miles, East of RT 7 between Rutland and Middlebury.

Texas Falls Recreation Area, 1 mile, off RT 125 between Hancock and Ripton.

Button Bay State Park, 1.4 miles, 20 miles south of Burlington near Vergennes.

Green Mountain Audubon Nature Center, .25 miles, between Huntington and Richmond.

Laplattee River Marsh Natural Area, 1.3 miles, south of Burlington near shore of Shelbourne Bay.

Missisquoi National Wildlife Refuge, 2.2 miles, 30 miles north of Burlington off RT78.

Black Mountain Natural Area, 2.3 miles, 5 miles north of Brattleboro off RT 30.

Groton State Forest, Kettle Pond and Owls Head, 3 miles, between Montpelier and St. Johnsbury, RT232.

Mont Hor, Hebert Hawks Trail, 2.4 miles, between West Burke and Orleans, RT5A.

Wenlock Wildlife, Moose Bog, 1.0 miles, midway between Island Pond and the Connecticut River, RT105.

Wheeler Mountain, 2.1 miles, between St. Johnsbury and Derby Line, off RT5.

Robert Frost Interpretive Trail, about 1 mile long, on Rt 125 between Hancock and Ripton.
